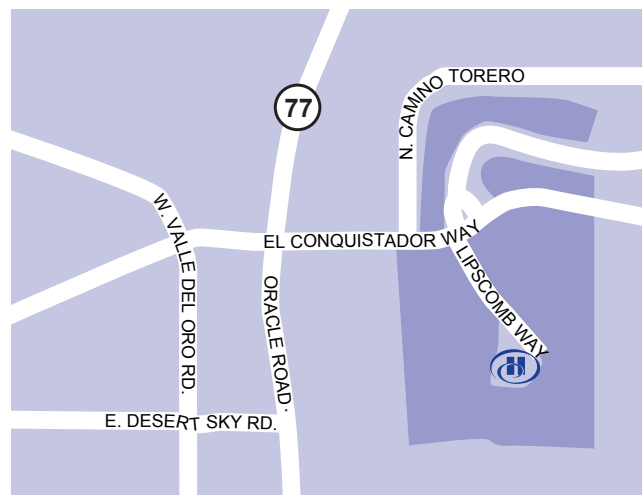
## Driving Directions from Tucson and Phoenix International Airports

### Directions from Tucson Int'l Airport:

Upon exiting the airport, travel 3 miles north on Tucson Blvd., which veers (left) onto Benson Highway. Travel .6 mile northwest on Benson Highway to Kino Parkway and turn north (right). Travel .6 mile on Kino Parkway to the I-10 west freeway entrance. Travel 15.1 miles on I-10 West. Follow I-10 West to Ina Road. Exit Ina Road, turn right and head east to Oracle Road (approx. 5.3 miles). Turn left onto Oracle Road (north) and continue 2.5 miles to El Conquistador Way. Turn right. Continue to veer to the right on Lipscomb Way and the resort will be on the right.

### From Phoenix Int'l Airport:

Follow I-10 East to Ina Road. Exit Ina Road, turn left and head east to Oracle Road (approx. 5.3 miles). Turn left onto Oracle Road (north) and continue 2.5 miles to El Conquistador Way. Turn right. Continue to veer to the right on Lipscomb Way and the resort will be on the right.
